NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") issued an Order on August 11, 2026, authorizing Cape Lookout Cabins & Camps, Inc., a North Carolina corporation d/b/a Cape Lookout Cabins & Camps Ferry Service and d/b/a Morris Marina Ferry Service (CALO), to increase and adjust its rates for leisure ferry transportation service in Carteret County, North Carolina, effective on August 11, 2026, as explained below. CALO operates as "Cape Lookout Cabins & Camps Ferry Service" for its route between Davis and South Core Banks and as "Morris Marina Ferry Service" for its route between Atlantic and North Core Banks. CALO operates as Cape Lookout Cabins & Camps for its route between Davis and the South Core Banks and as Morris Marina for its route between Atlantic and the North Core Banks.

Pursuant to the Commission's Order, CALO's new approved rates are as follows:
